

Kaete Klausner Scholarships for New Immigrant MA & Doctoral Students Academic Year 2024-2025

The Hebrew University is pleased to offer **Kaete Klausner Scholarships** to support *New Immigrants* ("Olim Hadashim") for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Scholarship Details:

- **3 scholarships** for MA students in the research track.
- **2 scholarships** for PhD students at the Hebrew University.

Eligibility:

- **New Immigrants:** Students who received Israeli citizenship after October 2018.
 - *Returning residents are not eligible.*
- Preference is given to those who made Aliyah alone.
- Candidates must have completed their previous degree **with distinction** (*Magna Cum Laude*).
- During the period of the scholarship, candidates must be enrolled in a full program of master's degree at The Hebrew University for the MA scholarship, or be a full-time student for the PhD. Scholarship.

Additional Criteria:

- MA students who started their studies within 6 years of receiving citizenship and are continuing to a PhD are eligible to apply, provided they do so within one year of completing their MA.
- Priority is given to students beginning their MA or PhD in the 2024-2025 academic year, but current students in their second year of an MA or already in a PhD program are also eligible.
 - For current students, scholarships are provided for the remaining years of study (up to 1 year for MA and 4 years for PhD).
 - The scholarship amount for PhD students already in the program will follow the amount designated for the respective year in the Klausner Scholarship Program.

Scholarship Duration and Renewal:

- MA: Up to 2 years.
- PhD: Up to 5 years.
- Renewal depends on academic performance, progress reports, and a recommendation from the PhD advisor.

Scholarship Amounts:

- **MA Students:** \$22,000/year.
- **PhD Students:** \$27,000/year.

- Additional one-time grant of **\$2,000** (split between the 1st and 2nd year) for a laptop or related equipment.
- **Tuition Assistance:**
 - PhD: \$1,500/year for the first two years, \$350/year for the remaining three years.
 - MA: \$3,700/year for two years.
- **Conference Travel Allowance** for PhD students:
 - \$1,000/year for the 2nd and 3rd years.
 - \$2,000/year for the 4th year.

Application Requirements:

Submit a single PDF file (the documents can be in English or Hebrew) including:

1. CV (with ID number, Israeli phone number, email, and thesis advisor's name)
2. Personal letter detailing your background and research plans.
3. Copy of your Oleh certificate and Israeli ID.
4. Transcripts of past studies abroad and in Israel (if applicable).
5. Two recommendation letters from faculty members. A third letter from the thesis advisor can be added (if available).

Application Process:

- Submit your application through your faculty's designated coordinator by the deadline set by your faculty.
